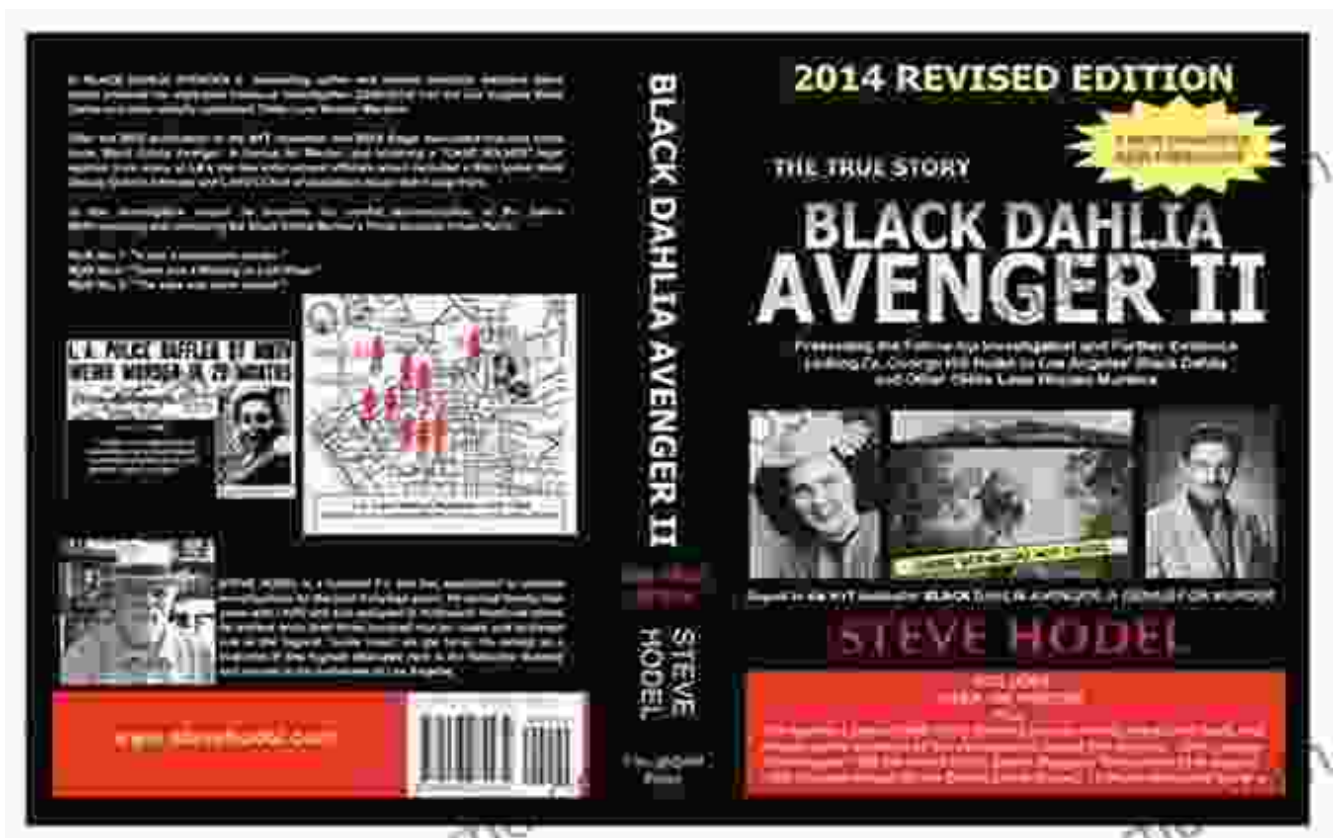


Black Dahlia Avenger II: The True Story

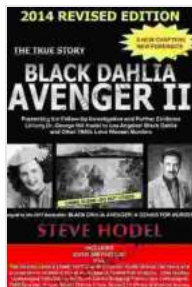

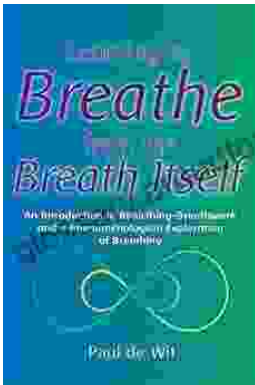
